Many individuals with special needs can't live independently because of unpredictable needs for support, but what if there was a way to know exactly when and what kind of help was needed instantly? And what if the right help could be provided on-demand? Imagine the improvement in quality of life and care costs if a person could receive immediate help in his or her own home exactly when it was needed and only for as long as needed. Could this kind of support affordably open doors for a better life? Of course it could!

The Faison Residence Program is Virginia's first residential model for semi-independent living for special needs individuals, leveraged by smart home and security technology – all embedded transparently into the fabric of this unique residential community. The Faison Residence allows for on-demand 24-7 care, which improves the quality of care while reducing costs.

The Faison Residence Program is a compassionate community of neighbors looking out for neighbors. An inclusive community of 45 apartments, of which up to 30% percent are tenants with special needs who are semi-independent, but need regular and intermittent support. The remaining units are rented to the public, making it a truly integrated community. The Faison Residence has a **limited number of openings** for persons with intellectual/developmental disabilities for fall of 2014.



The Faison 'Communiversy' Adult Day Services Program



Having places to go, performing meaningful work, and participating in enjoyable activities are important parts of a fulfilling lifestyle for most people. Faison's Communiversy extends and replaces traditional adult day services and provides expanded recreational opportunities, which are designed to enrich the lives of adults with special needs. The Communiversy encourages community involvement and utilization of existing community resources and is a strategic support program that develops, arranges, and coordinates community-focused life-long learning opportunities such as daily life skills, health and recreation programs, volunteering, work and enriched respite opportunities. Faison is accepting applications for a limited number of persons with intellectual/developmental disabilities.
